Donate your Boat to AuxAtm to Promote Boating Safety

Donate your boat to the Coast Guard AuxA Safety Program and help save lives!

It's Simple.

Certified Sales Inc. has been designated by AuxA to assist Auxiliarists who are interested in donating their boat's value to the Coast Guard Auxiliary through AuxA. All boat donation proceeds will be a contribution to the Coast Guard Auxiliary Association to help ensure that the Coast Guard Auxiliary is always "mission ready."

How does the boat donation process work?

CSI will ask you to describe the current condition of your boat and for photos of your boat. CSI will analyze the information to confirm that the boat can be sold for enough to cover transport, storage and other selling costs to have enough funds to donate to AuxA. If you are interested in donating your boat call Mike Costa directly, he can answer your questions.

Once I donate my boat, who is responsible for the boat and when can I stop boat insurance?

Once your boat is accepted for donation by AuxA, the donor then sends the original ownership documents to CSI. Upon receipt of the documents, CSI will take responsibility for the care and custody of the boat. The boat's storage needs to be current along with any open invoices. If the boat is on private slip or property CSI will arrange to transport the boat to a storage facility. Once successfully sold, AuxA pays the shipping, storage and related cost, plowing the difference into RBS programs.

The two best days in a boat owners life is the day you buy it... and the day you donate it to AuxA!



Coast Guard Mutual Assistance Program

Being a member of the Coast Guard Auxiliary is an honor and a privilege and a way in which many civilians give back to their country in the support of one of our five armed forces. No other branch of the services has an organization such as ours. The vast majority of our membership devote untold hours supporting the Coast Guard and never ask for anything in return.

There are many benefits of being an Auxiliarist but the most important one is being part of the "family." The Coast Guard truly takes care of its family in many ways. One way is an often forgotten organization called the Coast Guard Mutual Assistance Program. What is interesting about this is that this applies to the active duty, reserve, Auxiliarists, civilian employees, etc. Their motto is, "We take Care of Our Own." Their help can be in the form of non-interest bearing loans or even outright grants, depending on the circumstances.

This is a non-profit (501(c)(3)) organization set up to help ALL members of the family when times get really tough. How to get help? http://www.cgmahq.org/manual/forms/CGMA_05.pdf

Here is a small list of the kinds of assistance this program provides:

Disaster and Emergencies

- Basic Living Expenses (food, utilities, rent)
- Unexpected repairs (home, vehicle, etc.)
- Emergency travel
- Fire, hurricane, other disasters (dislocation, repairs, deductibles, food, personal property)
- Loss of funds

Education Assistance

- College Loan
- Supplemental Education Grants (SEG): books, fees, supplies
- Stafford/PLUS Loan Fee Reimbursement

Family Support

- Adoption
 Funerals
 Financial counseling
 Service animals
 Disability access
- Layette for newborns
 Special needs
 Respite care
 Pet support (medical, etc.)

Over the past 5 years alone here are some examples of how Auxiliarists have been the recipient of their help.... **2013**-\$41,545.24, **2014**-\$41,962.57, **2015**-\$29,164.84, **2016**-\$62,449.63 and **2017**-\$51,737.57

An Auxiliarist and spouse in D7 were in an automobile accident; \$1500 loan was provided to help with the cost of car repairs.

An Auxiliarist in D5 received two Special Education Grants (\$500/year) while pursuing an Undergraduate degree in Criminal Justice.

A disabled veteran Auxiliarist in D9 got behind on bills; an \$1100 loan helped prevent eviction.

An Auxiliarist in D8 received a \$2300 Disaster Grant following damage to the home due to Hurricane Harvey.

An Auxiliarist in D1 got both an Education Loan and Supplemental Education Grant while pursuing an undergraduate degree in Homeland Security.

There are a number of organizations that have Coast Guard in their name and most are very worthy organizations. Here's one that helps us when we really need it. If you find that you are a victim of a natural disaster or your immediate family needs some extra help, don't forget that you have a family member who just might be able to help.
