Those dollars are all contributed to AuxA in support of the Auxiliary's RBS mission. Sirius Signal also provides public RBS education by including Auxiliary's RBS messaging on its media platforms "Ask the Commodore."

"2020 had an incredible impact on the 'Water Sports' industry; recreational boating, kayaking, personal watercraft and all types of paddle craftsales soared to over 50% increase from 2019. Water Sports provided families with a safe way to enjoy recreation while keeping with social distancing protocols during the pandemic." Said Sirius Signal CEO Anthony Covelli in a recent interview for AuxA. Covelli also said that the tremendous increase in boating, kayaking last year has outpaced the need for fundamental safety training. "I think people buying a boat think 'hey, I can drive a car so I can drive a boat' and during a year where it was tough to join an inperson boating safety class, the gap between owning a boat and getting RBS education became much wider." Said Covelli.

He said that the Coast Guard Auxiliary provides the best opportunity to educate the boating/paddle craft community on fundamental safety on the water. "It's more important now than ever, no organized group can better close the gap than the Coast Guard Auxiliary." He encouraged boaters, kayakers to join the Auxiliary and stressed the need for Auxiliary recruiting efforts.

Steve Caldero, the CMO for Sirius Signal; "Education is the key. There's no 7-Eleven to turn into when I'm on my boat in the San Pedro Channel between LA and Catalina Island."



Sirius Signal key mission mirrors that of the Coast Guard Auxiliary, safety on the water. Their latest product, a smart phone app that will allow boaters/paddle craft participants to easily file a float plan to Coast Guard standards that will aid in taking necessary safety measures. The app is available to all boaters/kayakers. It is compatible with Android 5.0 and up and IOS 13.0 and up.

Features;

- 1. Files a float plan in just four easy steps. Can remotely activate the C-1002 eVDSD SOS light using your call phone or smartwatch.
- 2. Can send the float plan to designated contacts. P-2 Sirius for BOM
- 3. 911 Emergency messaging allowing boaters to send a distress text message to designated first responders such as USCG or towing service with Google Map position.
- 4. Every 15 minutes check-in after your plan's ETA.
- 5. Remote checking on battery status. siriusignal.com/application or call 888-526-0005

Covelli also previewed the transition in RBS from pyro-display signaling (pyro-flares) to electronic display signals such as the eVDSD C-1002 that meets all Coast Guard emergency signaling standards. "I remember, Steve Caldero said, when I ignited a hand-held pyro flare at an Auxiliary training class (before the pandemic) I had never done that before, I couldn't believe the heat, you can't look at it, it's dripping hot chemicals... I thought can you imagine doing this for the first time at night in a rough sea in an emergency?" Many boaters/kayakers are now transitioning away from pyro-display devices (flares) to the much safer, environmentally cleaner, electronic devices.

"We are very excited about the next generation of eVDSD technology that we will announce soon. Our mission at Sirius Signal is that as a boater, or paddle craft participant that you will always be safe, be seen and be found."







Just who are the people that are behind this AuxA effort? There is of course Bob Fabich, who creates this wondrous "Benefits of Membership" publication, working closely with Lou DiGiusto and me. I am now serving my 3rd NACO as CEO of AuxA. The NACO, National Commodore Alex Malewski, is also simultaneously the AuxA Chairman of the Board. 


